FROM THE PASTOR

Happy Trinity Sunday!

On this May 26, I celebrate the 6th anniversary of my ordination to the priesthood. I give thanks to the Almighty Trinitarian God – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, for this great gift of the priesthood. To live one’s vocation, one’s calling from God, is to make one happy. God calls all of us to be holy since there is a universal call to holiness, so if we live that, we will be happy.

Save the date of June 7th. That Friday is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Since our parish is named after the Sacred Heart of Jesus (and the Immaculate Heart of Mary), and since it is the Jubilee Year of the Sacred Heart of Jesus due to the 350 year anniversary of the apparition of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in France promoting devotion to His Sacred Heart, there is a special focus on our church as a pilgrimage site this year through June 2025. On this June 7, 2024, we will have a Mass for the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the evening. The morning Mass is cancelled. We will have a 5:00 p.m. Holy Hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Mass at 6:00 p.m., followed by a Eucharistic Procession, followed by a parish enthronement to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, followed by a light reception in Foeller Hall at 7:00 p.m. This is being advertised on St. Gabriel Radio and *The Catholic Times* so we expect others in the Diocese to come. Bishop Fernandes will be leading his Sacred Heart of Jesus pilgrimage in France at that time, so our celebration of this Solemnity will coincide with his celebration of it in France. He, himself, has a big devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus (you will even notice his Appeal theme “Respond to His Love” has the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus). Thanks to the Sacred Heart Enthronement Network in Columbus for helping to sponsor this celebration. We give thanks to Almighty God for the great gift of this opportunity to celebrate the Sacred Heart of Jesus in this way!

As a public service announcement, I want to warn everyone against scams. I heard on the news recently that more and more older adults are often the target of scams. Scammers are savvy and convincing, and their scams are designed to catch people off guard and scam them out of their money. Essentially, they call, email, or text you asking you to provide account info and make it sound urgent so that you will respond quickly without verifying if they are legitimate. They may also tell you that you need to pay money for something. Please do not fall for these scams. If you think it is a scam, just hang up, delete, and don’t answer the request. Or call the real organization or person back to find out if it is real. Along the same lines, I want to remind people that sometimes scammers will pose as me, because I am listed as the pastor in the bulletin or website, and they will text or email you and ask you to send a gift card. I would not make a request like this, so please either delete it or check with me before replying.
