FROM THE PASTOR

Happy Corpus Christi Sunday! As we celebrate the Body of Christ who we receive at Mass in the Eucharist, we give thanks to God for the wonderful gift of the Eucharist!

This Friday, June 7th, is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Since it is the Jubilee Year of the Sacred Heart of Jesus due to the 350-year anniversary of the apparition of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in France, promoting devotion to His Sacred Heart. Since our parish is named after the Sacred Heart of Jesus (and the Immaculate Heart of Mary), there is a special focus on our church as a pilgrimage site in the Diocese throughout this year and going through June 2025.

In honor of this special feast day for us, this Friday, June 7th, we will have a Mass for the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the evening. The morning Mass is cancelled. We will have a 5:00 p.m. Holy Hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, with Mass at 6:00 p.m., followed by a Eucharistic Procession. There will also be a parish enthronement to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, followed by a light reception in Foeller Hall. This is being advertised on St. Gabriel Radio and in *The Catholic Times*, so we expect others in the Diocese to come. Bishop Fernandes will be leading his Sacred Heart of Jesus pilgrimage in France at that time, so our celebration of this Solemnity will coincide with his celebration of it in France. He, himself, has a big devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus (you will even notice his Appeal theme "Respond to His Love" has the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus). Thanks to the Sacred Heart Enthronement Network in Columbus for helping to sponsor this celebration. We give thanks to Almighty God for the great gift of this opportunity to celebrate the Sacred Heart of Jesus in this way! Hope to see you on Friday evening!
