FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ! In this weekend's Gospel reading, Jesus is asleep on the boat while the storms rage around Him. If we have storms raging around us, it can seem that God doesn't care, or that He's asleep and doesn't hear us. But, He is there. Perhaps that is all we need to know. Would He allow the boat to sink if He is on it? So, why be terrified? The boat is also symbolic of the church. Despite the onslaught of the chaotic world, we are safe in the boat because Jesus is there. Jesus is king of heaven and earth. He is God and God created the world. Therefore, He has control even over the chaos. Let us be in awe that it is He whom even wind and sea obey!

We are unsafe, however, from the storms, the temptations, the chaos in the world, if we do not remain in the boat, if we do not remain in the Catholic Church, if we do not obey the Lord. Jesus founded His church and gave her authority to set the rules. One of the main rules for us is for our own good, that we have an obligation to go to Mass every Sunday. Knowing our weaknesses, if we did not have this obligation, we would fall away. So here is a reminder of our obligation to go to Mass. Obedience is a virtue.

Is Missing Sunday Mass a Mortal Sin?

"Missing Sunday Mass is a serious sin because you are putting something else at a higher priority than God. This is always the case unless you are physically unable to attend (e.g., illness, no transportation...).

If missing Mass involves full knowledge and full consent (basically you know you should go but choose not to), then it is a mortal sin.

For a sin to be a mortal sin, three conditions must be met:

- 1) Grave Offense it's seriously wrong,
- 2) Full Knowledge I fully know it's wrong, and
- 3) Full Consent I freely choose to do it.

To attend Mass is a privilege, and any and all Catholics should want to attend Mass. The ability to receive Jesus in the Eucharist on Sunday at Mass, is the greatest gift Jesus gave us on Earth. We should be excited to attend Mass to worship God and to receive the Eucharist.

Lastly, if someone intentionally misses Mass on Sunday or a Holy Day of Obligation, then he/she should not receive Holy Communion until he/she goes to Confession.

The reason for this is because we can never receive the Body and Blood of Christ in a state of mortal sin. And to receive the Eucharist in a state of mortal sin is a mortal sin."
