FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ!

Fr. Keller has gone and it is sad, but we look forward now to Fr. Daniel Colby joining us. Fr. Daniel has included a note introducing himself. One of his favorite saints is St. Maximilian Kolbe and I think he does not feel worthy of being associated with him, so he is going by Fr. Daniel. Please keep him in prayer as he begins his priestly ministry in parish life. We welcome Fr. Daniel to our parishes!

One parishioner recently said to me that they were sad when the priests leave and were worried about the changes. Of course, life always changes. One constant though is our shepherd Jesus Christ, who never abandons us. The motto of the Carthusians is "Stat crux dum volvitur orbis," which in Latin means, "The cross is steady while the world turns." Change is hard, but "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever" (Hebrews 13:8).

In this weekend's first reading, when the human shepherds fail, God says that He himself will pasture the flock. The Responsorial Psalm says "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want" (Psalm 23). In the Gospel reading, Jesus has such compassion on the people that despite not even being able to eat and rest, He continues to teach them many things. Whatever life's changes and challenges are, our Lord is no longer bound by bodily limitations and so He is always here for us, especially in the Eucharist, within Mass and outside of Mass. The cross is Jesus' love for us. The cross remains, so let us look upon His love and be at peace. For as St. Paul tells us in the second reading, Jesus is our peace.

Hello, parishioners of Sacred Hearts! I'm Father Daniel Colby, your new parochial vicar who will be arriving the weekend of July 27-28. I look forward to serving this community for the next few years. I served here as a seminarian from 2021-2022, so I know several of you already.

A little about myself. I was raised in Raleigh, North Carolina as a Presbyterian with my parents and three younger brothers. I went to Virginia Tech (go Hokies!) and graduated in 2013 with a degree in Product Design. I moved to Columbus in 2014 for work, and had a conversion to the Catholic faith after I learned my Dad was entering the Church. I entered RCIA and was received at the Easter Vigil in 2016. Within RCIA, I first felt the calling to the priesthood, and after entering the Church I began seminary at the Josephinum for the Diocese of Columbus in 2017. After two years of philosophy, four years of theology, and a pastoral year here with you all, I was ordained on May 18th of this year. I'm just returning from a summer Spanish immersion at a parish in Oakland, California.
