FROM THE PASTOR

Praised be Jesus Christ! This weekend at Mass, we finish hearing from the Gospel of John, Chapter 6, the Bread of Life Discourse. It is the end of the chapter and it is at this point we hear that many who were disciples of Jesus could not accept His teaching that they must eat His flesh and drink His blood in order to have eternal life. Jesus is not oblivious to their disbelief, so He asks, "Does this shock you?" Yet, they turned away and no longer followed Him. They would not have walked away if Jesus was only speaking symbolically of His body and blood and He would not have let them walk away if He was only speaking symbolically. He was indeed speaking literally. Can we accept this teaching that we truly do eat His flesh and drink His blood in the Eucharist? Jesus tells us that we do need the gift of the Holy Spirit to understand and accept this teaching, so ask for the Holy Spirit!

On a side note, the Catholic apologist Tim Staples writes why eating the flesh and blood of Jesus in the Eucharist is not cannibalism. He says, "The charge of cannibalism does not hold water for at least three reasons. First, Catholics do not receive our Lord in a cannibalistic form. Catholics receive Him in the form of bread and wine. The cannibal kills his victim; Jesus does not die when He is consumed in Communion. Indeed, He is not changed in the slightest; the communicant is the only person who is changed. The cannibal eats part of his victim, whereas in Communion the entire Christ is consumed—body, blood, soul, and divinity. The cannibal sheds the blood of his victim; in Communion our Lord gives Himself to us in a non-bloody way" ("What Catholics Believe about John 6" at Catholic.com 11/1/2010).

Finally, if you have doubts about Jesus, just answer with faith as Simon Peter did, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." If we are convinced that Jesus is God, how can we doubt that Jesus can do anything including giving us His flesh and blood to eat? And when He does so, He changes us from within to become more like Him, to become more Christ-like. As St. Athanasius said, "The Son of God became man so that man might become God [by grace]." The Eucharist is this gift that gives us the grace to share in the divine nature.

As we near September, PSR, Confirmation classes, and OCIA will be beginning. For PSR (Parish School of Religion), please remember that the parish provides the service of teaching the Catholic religion to our children. Parents are still the first educators of the faith to their children. The responsibility of the parents is primarily to be living the faith at all times (example) and raising their kids in that faith (teaching). The parish provides the formal instruction to help the parents. It is our desire that children who are not in Catholic school, go to PSR to receive formal instruction in the faith, in all years, not just the sacramental years (First Communion and Confirmation). Please see the bulletin for more details. And thank you to all of our catechists and volunteers who are helping to teach our kids! If anybody has an 8th grader for Confirmation and has not been in contact about getting them registered for Confirmation classes, please email Clare at claregaluzny@gmail.com.

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) is for those adults who want to learn about the Catholic religion and possibly to become Catholic at Easter. Weekly classes will begin in the fall. An exact date will be announced. If you know of anybody

who would like to become Catholic, please invite them to consider it and be on the lookout for the dates.

You will notice that we have a new church sign going in just beside the entryway. It will match our current church architecture. The old sign will go away, but the stone base will remain in the hopes that we can put new statues in its place.


